Weather forecast

I have noticed a quick change in the weather in the Southwest. Rain, hail and cold winds have hit and being an old farmer I love winter as long as I don't get wet and cold.

Utilising our homes assets to provide warmth, comfort and reduce our heating costs is important. Keeping our North facing window treatments open to allow sun penetration to warm our thermal mass, shut off rooms in the house not being used and of course wearing the appropriate clothing will reduce the need for artificial heating.

Double glazing will not prevent solar radiation but will stop heat loss. Low-e glass will allow solar radiation and prevent solar radiation loss. The result of the clever use of glass will enhance our energy efficiency and reduce ongoing costs.

The NW of the state is maintaining a warm environment and our use of shading, cross flow ventilation, cooling thermal mass effect, lightweight construction for little heat gain and quick heat loss provide maximum living comfort.

Double glazing will prevent heat gain and achieving a balanced glass to floor area percentage should be encouraged.
