EDDIE'S CORNER

FLOOR COVERINGS

Floor coverings play a vital role in energy efficiency and achieving a 6.0 star NatHERS rating.

Various combinations provide different outcomes for a floor covering and these include thermal mass, insulation, orientation, glazing and living zone type.

In the south of the state polished concrete, tiles and slate all provide the thermal mass to heat our zones whereas carpets, vinyl and laminated timber floors provide an insulating factor.

In the north of the state polished concrete, tiles and slate can provide a cooling affect if the solar radiation is unable to penetrate to these surfaces and the interior of the zone is kept cool.

Keep in mind what the zone is being used for (Living, Bed etc), the time of the day or night it is being used, the location, the orientation and the prevailing climatic conditions.
