Boy who "could build a house on his own" is one of 60 boys at St. Joseph's Farm and Trades School, Bindoon. He is 15-year-old orphan George Guidici who has been with the Christian Brothers at Clontarf and Bindoon since he was seven. Of Italian parentage, but Australian born, he has shown marked aptitude for building and has mast-ered more than a working knowledge of stonemasonry, plast-ering, moulding and carpen-try.

try. "He could build a house on his own, from the foundations to the roofing." said Bindoon Superior Brother Paul Keaney.

"Work he has done at the farm and trades school is worthy of a fin-shed tradesman."

shed tradesman." George is of a retiring disposition and does not mix much with the other boys but finds great plessure in moulding, a flair for which he de-veloped only recently. Now he has a large room with a concrete moulding table and equip-ment for his own use. He spendi neurs there and has turned out some excellent work including fancy con-crete balustrades for the school, plas-er ventilators, etc.

Happy in his work, he is always reking new methods, new designs.
