This qualification is suitable for those wishing to become a Registered Builder in Western Australia.

This qualification will comprise the following units of competency:

BSBPMG505A	Manage project quality.
BSBPMG508A	Manage project risk.
CPCBC4003A	Select and prepare a construction contract.
CPCBC4004A	Identify and produce estimated costs for building and construction projects.
CPCBC4005A	Produce labour and material schedules for ordering.
CPCBC4010A	Apply structural principles to residential low rise constructions
CPCBC4013A	Prepare and evaluate tender documentation.
CPCBC4014A	Prepare simple sketches and drawings.
CPCBC4018A	Apply site surveys and set-out procedures to building and construction projects.
CPCBC5001B	Apply building codes and standards to the construction process for medium rise building projects.
CPCBC5002A	Monitor costing systems on medium rise building and construction projects.
CPCBC5003A	Supervise the planning of on-site medium rise building or construction work.
CPCBC5005A	Select and manage building and construction contractors.
CPCBC5007A	Administer the legal obligations of a building or construction contract.
CPCBC5010A	Manage construction work.
CPCBC5018A	Apply structural principles to the construction of medium rise buildings
CPCBC4001A	Apply building codes and standards to the construction process for low rise building projects.
CPCSUS5001A	Develop workplace policies and procedures for sustainability.

PRE-REQUISITE: There is no pre-requisite however, Master Builders prefers participants to have at least 5 years of construction industry experience and for participants to be computer literate.

ON COMPLETION: After successful completion of this course, you will be issued with a National Diploma CPC50210 Diploma of Building and Construction that meets the educational requirements for Builders Registration in Western Australia.

DURATION: 4 days per month (Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday) for a 6 month period (24 days x 8 hours) plus, after hours assignment work.
