



## JOB SAFETY ANALYSIS

The JSA training course intends to educate all parties in the development of a Job Safety Analysis for a work task in the building and construction industry.

## At the end of the course participants will be able to:

- Define duty of care responsibilities of employers, main contractors, self employed and employees.
- Identify, assess and control hazards associated with construction and building work tasks.
- To identify when a JSA is required under the legislation.
- To identify hazards at work and to take positive action to reduce or eliminate those hazards, using the preferred order of control.
- To develop a safe system of work through the preparation of a Job Safety Analysis, for a job task, in consultation with persons involved in the task.
- Review a Job Safety Analysis for compliance with the minimum requirements of the OSH legislation.
- Understand the importance to work together to secure a safe workplace.
