Amendments were made to the OSH Regulations to allow a competent person to test and tag portable electrical equipment for use on a construction and/or demolition site. As required by the Occupational Safety and Health Act and Regulations the course provides participants with the knowledge and skills required to test and tag portable electrical equipment on demolition, construction and mine sites.

Required pre-requisite: It is required by the training provider - Frontline Safety & Training that you have obtained the Work Safely in the Construction Industry CPCCOHS1001A (white card) obtained after October 2009, and to provide a copy of your Statement of Attainment together with your registration form.

On successful completion you will receive your Statement of Attainments for UEENEEP026A Conduct in-service safety testing of electrical cord assemblies and cord connected equipment and UEENEEE101A Apply Occupational Health and Safety regulations, codes and practices in the workplace.
