- The Tender Process The way most contracts are negotiated and formed. Understand how the process 1. works, manage risk and reward and form effective contracts.

  - Building Services Legislation The new building services legislation covers:
    - o Dispute Resolution through the Building Commission and State Admin Tribunal;
    - o The new builder's registration system; and
    - New procedures for building permits and certifications.
