2017 BANKWEST BEST COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL BUILDING

Nominees are selected from the winners of any Commercial Project Category Award. Joint winners may be awarded. The winner/s of this Award will compete in the 2017 Master Builders-Bankwest Excellence in Construction Awards for the title of Best Regional Project as well as the Bankwest Best Project.

2017 THE LAMINEX GROUP BEST COUNTRY HOME

Nominees are selected from the winners of the Contract Home Category Awards. Joint winners may be awarded. The winner/s of this Award will compete in the 2017 Master Builders-Bankwest Housing Excellence Awards for the title of Best Country Home as well as the Bankwest Top WA Home.

SPECIAL AWARDS

COMMERCIAL/RESIDENTIAL SUPERVISOR OF THE YEAR

Recognises the quality of supervision on a nominated project. The job should demonstrate squareness of setout, plumbness of walls, attention to detail and cleanliness and finish of the job in general..

Requires a separate entry form.

BEST NEW BUILDER

A builder registered for five (5) years or less, displaying qualities befitting a 'Master Builder' including: Quality of workmanship; attention to detail, excellent safety standards, innovation, and completion of projects on time and on budget. Address the criteria in a one (1) page document and include with your entry. Attach any relevant supporting documentation.

SMALL BUILDER OF THE YEAR | UNDER 20 PROJECTS

This award recognises a Small Builder (less than 20 projects per year) who has achieved the highest construction excellence across all projects entered in this year's Master Builders-Bankwest Building Excellence Awards. Must have entered three (3) or more projects and achieved a minimum of one (1) price category award to be eligible. Please provide written evidence to show how many projects completed over past 12 months. Must enter the 2017 Best Customer Service Awards to be eligible and submit a one (1) page doc outlining quality control & supervision procedures and Adherence to a building works programme. **Requires a separate entry form**

PROJECT BUILDER OF THE YEAR | OVER 20 PROJECTS

This award recognises a Project Builder (20 projects or more per year) who has achieved the highest construction excellence across all projects entered in this year's Master Builders-Bankwest Building Excellence Awards. Must have entered eight (4) or more projects and achieved a minimum of one (1) price category award to be eligible. Please provide written evidence to show 20 projects or more completed over past 12 months. Must enter the 2017 Customer Service Awards and submit a one (1) page doc outlining quality control & supervision procedures and Adherence to a building works programme. **Requires a separate entry form**

INNOVATIVE CONSTRUCTION FOR SMALL LOTS

Innovative building techniques in constructing a home on a lot less than 400m² and overcoming challenges of a project on a restricted site.

EXCELLENCE IN LANDSCAPING

Entrants must display a high level of skill & execution of constructing the landscaping of a project. Includes concrete works, paving, decks/pagolas, tiling, retaining walls, driveways and structure of garden beds. Must enter the project first to be eligible for this category.

ANCILLARY DWELLING

An ancillary dwelling or 'granny flat' is self-contained accommodation on the same lot as a single house, which may or may not be physically attached. It also includes 'Fonzie flats' that are dwellings over existing or new garages, or separate rear studios with a shared lobby entry or separate external access. Ancillary dwellings can be pre-manufactured or built to specifications onsite.

SILVER TROWEL

Recognises the quality of workmanship involved in the sharpness of all brick and block work including horizontal and vertical alignment, selection and mixing of brick batches, consistency of mortar colour and joints, and the plumbness of windows and cuts to brickwork.

APPRENTICE OF THE YEAR

Recognises the quality of workmanship involved in the sharpness of all brick and block work including horizontal and vertical alignment, selection and mixing of brick batches, consistency of mortar colour and joints, and the plumbness of windows and cuts to brickwork.

Requires a separate entry form

BEST COMMERCIAL BUILDER

A registered commercial builder displaying qualities befitting a 'Master Builder' including: quality of workmanship, attention to detail, excellent safety standards, innovation, and completion of projects on time and on budget. Address the criteria in a one (1) page document and include with your entry. Attach any relevant supporting documentation.

TRADE AWARDS

No additional fee is payable and all entries are eligible. For all trade awards address the criteria in a one (1) page document and include with your entry. Attach any relevant supporting documentation

MOST LIVEABLE HOME

This award will showcase WA builders who have considered accessibility and adaptability of a new home or renovation to maximise space and enable people of all ages and abilities to live or visit in comfort. Features for consideration include wide flat level entries, easy access toilets, hobless showers, wide hallways and doorways and strong toilet walls.

EXCELLENCE IN CONSTRUCTION ON A CHALLENGING LOT

Innovation that overcomes challenges based on location, accessibility, terrain or lot size.

EXCELLENCE IN ENERGY EFFICIENCY

Recognises energy efficient building design, including lighting and energy management systems that reduces the buildings carbon footprint, beyond the 6 star requirements that are currently legislated at the time of judging.

WATER WISE HOME

Implementation of water efficiency in construction, considering water pressure regulation, grey or black water systems, water harvesting, water fixtures (including taps, showers, baths, toilets, spas, pools and any appliances) and any outside landscaping or irrigation done.

EXCELLENCE IN BRICK PAVING

Preparation of site (ie flatness of area), alignment of pavers, finish of edges and general finish.

EXCELLENCE IN CARPENTRY (INTERNAL/EXTERNAL)

Recognises quality of workmanship in ballustrading, door margins, jointing of moldings, finishing to hinges, latches, strikers, skills and returned scotias, shelving and general workmanship.

EXCELLENCE IN STRUCTURAL CARPENTRY (ROOF AND WALL FRAMING AND TIMBER CLADDING)

Timber framed roof (eg exposed timber), timber wall framing, alignment of walls and use of external linings.

EXCELLENCE IN PLASTER (INTERNAL/EXTERNAL)

Recognises excellent results in areas of surface texture, consistency, square and plumb arises, reveals, corners, map cracking/crazing, scouring to internals, corners and window reveals.

EXCELLENCE IN CONCRETING

Difficulty of area/site, use of construction joints, overall finish and appearance.

EXCELLENCE IN FLOOR AND WALL TILING

Recognises workmanship that includes setouts, margins, scribing of tiles and waste cuts, steps, jollies, grouting including sealants around wall and floor tile junctions. Includes kitchen, bathroom and general area floors.

EXCELLENCE IN PAINTING

Recognises workmanship including general finish, preparation work, coverage of paint to door tops and bottoms, frames, sills, moldings and consistency of finish. Must be a Registered Painter.

EXCELLENCE IN ROOFING (METAL)

Recognises quality workmanship in the alignment of gutters, eaves, details to exposed timber areas, plan of roof, fixing of materials, flashing, hip and valley alignment and the finish of cuts and joints.

EXCELLENCE IN CABINETRY (FIT-OUT)

Bench top joints, door/drawer alignment, door stops, ease of drawers, internal quality of fixing, edging, colour consistency, fixing of appliance/sinks, plumbness of cupboards and alignment of handles.

EXCELLENCE IN PLASTERBOARD CEILINGS & WALLS

Recognises excellent results in areas of surface texture, consistency, square and plumb arises, reveals, corners, scouring to internals & corners.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Entrants should address the following guidelines in no more than (1) page per item. Entrants may wish to attach supporting material as an appendix.

RESIDENTIAL PROJECTS

- ☞ External finishes i.e. brickwork, render, cladding etc
- ☞ Roof alignment and quality of finish
- ☞ Internal plastering, brickwork, cladding etc
- ☞ Ceiling finishes
- ☞ Carpentry and fixing
- ☞ Wall and floor tiling
- ☞ Painting internal and external (if part of contract)
- ☞ Proficiency of supervision
- ☞ Integrity of structure

COMMERCIAL PROJECTS

INNOVATION

ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS

- ☞ Integration of new addition with existing structure

On site judging will take place between 17 July - 21 July 2017. Where possible, entrants will receive a minimum one week's notice of the time and date. Changes to inspection times cannot be guaranteed.

PROJECT CATEGORIES

RESIDENTIAL

MULTI RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENTS

Includes a development on a single allotment (may be strata-titled) with three or more grouped dwellings (Class 1a buildings as defined by the Building Code of Australia). This category does not include apartment buildings.

Includes Class 2 residential apartments and Class 3 housing for seniors, as defined by the Building Code of Australia.

RESIDENTIAL ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS

Includes extensions, alterations, renovations and restoration of an existing dwelling.

Includes structural building work so as to extend, alter, renovate or restore an existing dwelling.

Note: Entrants in Alterations, Additions and Restorations will also be reviewed on the integration of any transitions from the existing structure to new works.

DISPLAY HOMES

Includes a home that has been designed, built and displayed with the intention of building identical homes in other locations.

Includes homes that are on display and advertised as open to the public during regular specified hours between close of entries and one month after the Awards presentation.

Includes entries that **must** be accompanied by a letter or similar from the developer or local authority acknowledging that the dwelling is approved for use as a designated display.

CONTRACT HOMES

Includes any dwelling that has been designed and built on contract specifically for that site and according to the requirements and brief of the client.

Includes any dwelling that has been constructed for the purposes of display that, at the time of entry, has **not** been approved by the local authority or developer as a display home.

Includes one unit of a duplex, triplex, unit development or group development (divide the overall contract price by the number of units to determine price category).

POLE HOMES

A dwelling that has pole or timber stumps, pole or timber floor framing and timber walls.

TRANSPORTABLE HOMES

Transportable homes include:

- Factory built homes transported to site in one or more major sections that comprise all the components of that portion of the home (ie frame, external and internal walls, roof, ceilings, floors, windows, doors, internal plumbing and wiring, tiling, kitchen, bathroom and laundry fittings, and built-in cupboards and cabinets).
- Homes that have been transported to site, with the intention of being relocated at a later time.
- Homes that are made of pre-fabricated parts which have not been manufactured in the form of one or more major sections. These entries must have also been built by a registered builder, rather than an owner-builder.

All entries must include at least one kitchen, bathroom, bedroom and living area, plus toilet and laundry facilities.

BEST STEEL BUILDING

Innovative use of cold-formed steel, sheet metal or cladding product in structural or visual elements.

COMMERCIAL

COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL BUILDINGS

Includes buildings utilised as factories, warehouses, retail or office space, or for hospitality purposes such as restaurants and hotels. The category covers those buildings recognised as Classes 5-10 by the Building Code of Australia and only includes Class 2-4 residential buildings that are not covered by our residential categories.

COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL ALTERATIONS & ADDITIONS

Refurbishment or renovation of, or addition to, an existing commercial building. Must incorporate structural building work so as to alter, extend or renovate an existing commercial building.

BEST CIVIL ENGINEERING WORKS

Includes roads, railways, bridges, tunnels, car parks and utility infrastructure. Category also includes residential or commercial subdivisions i.e. roads, retaining walls, parks, lakes, streetscaping and other infrastructure.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Please be aware that the emphasis of judging for project entries is based on the onsite inspection by a team of judges. In addition, the following information must accompany each entry:

All Entries

- A fully completed entry form for each project, including signed declarations and entry fee
- List of subcontractors/trades engaged on the project
- A copy of the current street directory which highlights the property location to the nearest cross road or a copy of a Google map.
- Simplified A4 floor plan of each project

Residential Entries

- A sixty (60) word synopsis that can be used in all editorials in 'Word' format
- Trade/Specialists awards address the criteria in a one (1) page document. Attach any relevant supporting documentation.

Alterations and Additions

- Please also include simplified 'before' floor plans

Display Home Entries

- Advertising brochure
- Letter of authority from Local Authority or Developer

Commercial & Industrial Entries including Alterations & Additions

- A detailed description of each project that addresses the judging criteria (max 1 page per criteria). Please provide concise and relevant details and technical information about the project

Photographs with Entries

Photographs must be submitted with all Alterations & Additions entries. Note: Entrants must submit CDs or USBs containing a copy of the photos. Resolution of 300dpi with image size of 297 mm x 210mm in jpg, .psd or .tif format.

Alterations and Additions entries

- Include two (2) INTERNAL and two (2) EXTERNAL 'before' photographs where possible

Professional Photography with Entries

Alterations and additions must provide, before photos and progress photo as per the above requirement, final photos will be done at judging by the photographer.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Project Award and Special Award categories (excluding Apprentice of the Year and Supervisor of the Year) are open to all registered builders/building companies only, and must operate in the Great Southern region.
2. Best Customer Service Award is open to Master Builders Association Building members only.
3. Entries must have achieved practical completion on or before 16 June 2017 or prior to judging commencing. Entries which do not achieve this time frame will be disqualified and all fees are forfeited.
4. Projects which have been previously judged in the Master Builders Great Southern awards program cannot be re-entered.
5. All applicable sections of the entry form must be completed and the required documentation provided by the closing date (including payment).
6. Nominated projects that are withdrawn after the close of entries and entries that are not accompanied by the completed and required documentation will forfeit all associated fees.
7. If the information given on the entry form varies extensively from the entry inspected, in specification or value, the judges reserve the right to disqualify or re-categorise the entry without consultation with the builder.
8. If there is only one entry in a category, judges reserve the right to re-categorise the entry.
9. Should a minimum standard of excellence not be reached in any category, the judges reserve the right to re-categorise the entry or decline to present a category award.
10. Judges' decisions are final and no correspondence or review will be entered into by Master Builders.
11. Owner's consent must be given for entry in the Awards for all entries (display homes excepted). Entries without a signed declaration will not be accepted. Where the property is tenanted, the owner is responsible for compliance with access requirements. Where the property has been built as the builder's residence or investment property, this should be declared as it may impact on the price category allocation.
12. Any material supplied with the entry may be reproduced in media releases, publications, websites and other promotional material at the discretion of the Master Builders Association. The entrant indemnifies Master Builders against any claims in respect of copyright. Master Builders and associated media accept no responsibility for incorrect details, spelling or other incorrect information stated in the entry form.
13. Each builder will be notified in writing of the judging time and date for each project. It is the builder's responsibility to confirm with the owners and obtain access for the judges. In the instance of not being able to obtain access, the entry will be automatically disqualified and the entry fee forfeited.
14. The builder must submit evidence of the final contract sum (including variations) for each entry inclusive of GST.
15. Award winners will NOT be disclosed until the announcement at the awards presentation on 16 September 2017.
16. The builder may use success in the Awards for promotional purposes but agrees to adhere to high ethical standards in that promotion. Advertising and promotional activities must not be misleading or deceptive. Without limiting this requirement, the builder agrees to be bound by the following:
 - ✎ Until the winners and finalists are officially announced at the awards on 16 September 2017, the builder will not promote any unofficial or speculative success.
 - ✎ In any promotion, the exact award category and the year of the award must be stated.
 - ✎ In press advertising text setting out this detail must be a minimum of 12-point font size.
 - ✎ In promotional signage text setting out this detail must be a minimum of 100mm in height.
 - ✎ In display project categories, signage must be restricted exclusively to the judged project.
 - ✎ Winners and finalists should target the marketing of the award to the area that the award was presented in, where possible.
17. If the entrant breaches these requirements governing promotion, Master Builders Association may:
 - ✎ Revoke the entrants' award.
 - ✎ Refuse the entrant entry in future Awards.

17. Display home entries must:
