Mid-West Economic Prospects Forum

According to Master Builders Director Michael McLean the mid-west region is at the cross-roads and its future direction remains unclear.

"Like most regions in WA, the mid-west is struggling and operating very much below its capacity to deliver," Mr McLean said.

"New building approvals are well below the region's 10 year average and established home prices have fallen to reduce the stock of properties on the market for sale."

"We have assembled a first class panel of speakers, including Bankwest's Chief Economist, Alan Langford, RSM's Director of Business Advisory, Trevor Lake, REIWA's Advocacy and Policy Manager, Sadie Davidson and Midwest Development Commission Chairman, Todd West to raise awareness of where future opportunities lie for the region," Mr McLean said.

"It is rare to get such a high calibre panel of expertise all focused on future prospects for the midwest."
