

DISCLAIMER RIDE AGAINST SUICIDE 6 APRIL 2019

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Make sure you read and understand)

Participants in the Ride Against Suicide on 6 April 2019 declare and agree that they are participating in this event of their own free will and entirely at their own risk.

Participants do so in full knowledge of the risks associated with riding a motorcycle on a public road. These risks include, but are not limited to, the risk that participants may suffer harm, personal injury or loss of life as a result of an accident, including a collision with other participants or other road users.

Participants warrant that they are in a fit state of health to participate and that the motorcycle they will be riding or on which they will be a pillion passenger, will be in good repair and condition during the Ride Against Suicide.

Participants agree to abide by the rules laid down by the organisers of the event and to ride their motorcycle in compliance with WA road rules at all times during the event.

Master Builders, any of its sponsors, organisers or any of its employees, officers, agents or volunteers when acting in their official capacity as organisers of the event accept no responsibility in respect of any liability, loss or costs arising or that may arise at any time, directly or indirectly, from participants participation in the Ride Against Suicide.

Participants also agree to indemnify Master Builders and any of its employees, officers, agents or volunteers, for any liability, loss or costs that they may incur at any time arising or that may arise, directly or indirectly, from any act or omission on participants part (negligent or otherwise), including, but not limited to, participants failure to abide by the rules of the event (including WA road rules).

Participants understand and acknowledge that it is their responsibility to make all insurance arrangements in respect of themselves and/or their motorcycle. As a rider, participants further warrant that they are, and will be whilst participating in the event, the holder of a current motorcycle licence and will be riding a currently registered motorcycle.
