Builders welcome Covid-19 restrictions lifted on display homes

"A recent survey of members completed by Master Builders indicated that from over 70% of respondents noted on average a 40% decline in their pipeline of work, so now is great time to ease these restrictions, encouraging those considering buying home back to display villages and display homes in WA, which will lead to more homes being built.
