Kimberley Recovery Plan supports builders July 30, 2020

The \$110.9 million Kimberley Recovery Plan gives assurance of continuing work for the building industry and will create jobs for local tradies and apprentices.

Master Builders WA executive director John Gelavis said the WA Government had listened to industry calls for investment in local infrastructure across the state.

"Powering up government projects such as upgrading education centres and launching infrastructure work will give the local building industry a boost," Mr Gelavis said.
