Apprentice

Applicants will be assessed on their overall standard of achievement and potential, taking all the information provided in this nomination form into consideration. Please complete each section in full. Address all criteria where relevant and where there is insufficient space, please attach any additional information. Please ensure as much information as possible is provided in the entry as the judges review the submissions to determine the winners of each category.

Requirements for all Apprentice entries include:

A completed entry submission

Supporting documentation where requested

1 x High res photo (headshot) - clear and showing the entrants face

1x High res photo (on site) - clear and showing the entrants face

A statement about the nominated apprentice addressing the below

-Examples of work undertaken on site by the apprentice

-What projects they have undertaken recently (noting unusual projects or work displaying a high level of skill)

-Why they deserve to be recognised as the best in their trade

Other supporting documentation (e.g. references from staff/lecturers)

JUDGING CRITERIA

Apprentice Categories

A panel of industry judges, as chosen by Master Builders WA will first review every written submissions.

Phone or face to face interviews may be schedules - the MBA WA Events team will coordinate this.

Apprentices will be judged on the following:

Work ethic and attitude toward work
Communication skills
Ability to follow directions and complete tasks as directed
Level of competency
Commitment to safety
Academic results and awards
Non-academic awards, prizes or achievements
Work undertaken for the community or other work experience
Future plans for their career in the industry

For non-apprentice categories, entries will be judged off submissions.

MBA WA Events may contact entrants to obtain further information, or possiblly interview entrants as chosen by the judges, be it on site or at the MBA West Perth office.

MAJOR APPRENTICE AWARD CATEGORIES

Winners from across all categories compete for the best Major Awards.

These are non-entered category as the best overall scoring Apprentices from all entries received automatically become finalists for these awards.

APPRENTICE OF THE YEAR (non-entered)

Recognises overall best building and construction industry apprentices across all categories who have demonstrated commitment to their training. Applicants will be assessed on their overall achievement in studies and on-the-job training.

BEST REGIONAL APPRENTICE (non-entered)

Recognises building and construction industry apprentices who have demonstrated commitment to their training. Applicants will be assessed on their overall achievement in studies and on-the-job training. The overall winner from winning Goldfields-Esperance, Midwest, Great Southern, South West and Kimberley-Pilbara Apprentice will go into the running for the 'Apprentice of the Year' Award, to be presented in Perth.

The Ric New "Medal for Excellence" aims to recognise outstanding potential, work ethic and commitment of a young person (under 40 years of age as of 30 September 2022) in the context of their current and future contribution to the building and construction industry in Western Australia.

RIC NEW RISING STAR AWARD

The Ric New "Rising Star" Award aims to recognise outstanding potential, work ethic and commitment of a young person (under 30 years of age as of 30 September 2022) in the context of their current and future contribution to the building and construction industry in Western Australia.

EMPLOYER TRAINER AWARD

Recognises the building and construction industry employers who are committed to training. Applicants will be assessed on their overall commitment to providing training to employees/apprentices.

APPRENTICE ENCOURAGEMENT AWARD (non-entered)

The Judges will select a first or second year apprentice who has signifigiantly stood out to them, either from improvement and hard work, committment to their employer, staff or other.
