The WA projects bringing excellence back to building and construction

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The who's who of Western Australia's building and construction industry gathered for a black tie gala at Crown Perth last night to celebrate the inaugural Master Builders WA Building Excellence Awards.

The awards night is a WA first, as never before has the incredible work produced by all three sectors of the building and construction industry been recognised and celebrated at one event.

Results from the residential, commercial and civil construction categories culminated in the announcement of three major awards:

1. **Young Builder of the Year**, which celebrates a builder under 40 years of age who has demonstrated a commitment to excellence in the building and construction industry.
2. **Residential Home of the Year**, which is awarded to the best overall Residential Home that has also won in a residential price category.
3. **Commercial Project of the Year**, which recognises the best overall Commercial Project across all commercial price category winners.

2025's **Young Builder of the Year** is redefining the future of sustainable construction.

Denmark-based **Patrick John Parry of JP Sustainable Homes** is known for his dedication to craftsmanship, innovation, and environmental responsibility. Mr Parry's leadership in sustainable practices has earned him industry recognition and positioned his business at the forefront of responsible residential building in regional Western Australia.

His company is named in honour of his late grandfather, John Patrick French, a bricklayer and member of the ancient Irish Bricklayers Guild, whose respect for his trade and the environment continues to inspire Mr Parry's approach today.

The Young Builder of the Year category is partnered by James Hardie.

An opulent western suburbs home built by **Tony Tomizzi Builders** was crowned **Residential Home of the Year** after also winning **Contract Home \$4 Million to \$6 Million**, pipping projects by BD Partington Building Contractors and Dlux Builders.

Inspired by the timeless architecture of The University of Western Australia and the House of Parliament, the luxury **Dalkeith** residence combines classical elegance with modern sophistication.

Stand-out features include hand-laid Croatian stonework, meticulously finished interiors, and a cutting-edge geothermal system to provide efficient climate control for the home and pool.

The Residential Home of the Year category is partnered by Ford & Doonan Air Conditioning.

Meanwhile, **Multiplex** had a very successful evening, taking out **Commercial Project of the Year** and **High-Rise Apartment Building Over 3 Storeys - Over \$50 Million** for The Grove Residences in **Claremont** as well as a host of other category awards for their Murdoch Square development.

The 15,741sqm site redefines urban luxury living with a sophisticated blend of architecture, amenities, and lifestyle offerings over four interconnected buildings.

Residents benefit from world-class amenities at The Sanctuary, including a lap pool, spa, cold plunge, gym, sauna, steam room, media room, and golf simulator, alongside indoor and outdoor dining options, a workshop, and landscaped garden areas.

With 228 residences (from studio apartments to four-bedroom penthouses), five commercial tenancies and 578 parking bays integrated into the precinct, The Grove delivers a complete, connected lifestyle in one of Claremont's most desirable locations.

The Commercial Project of the Year category is partnered by Commercial Aquatics.

Master Builders WA CEO Matt Moran said that being an MBAWA award winner now meant more than ever.

"The new Building Excellence Awards launched last night with refreshed categories, a streamlined judging process, and a sharper focus on celebrating true industry excellence," said Mr Moran.

"These awards raise the bar higher. For the first time, regional members now compete on equal footing with their metropolitan counterparts, with many winners advancing to represent WA on the national stage."

"The reimagining of our awards program reflects MBAWA's commitment to supporting our members and strengthening the industry's future."

Master Builders WA Board member and Chief Judge Rob Shaw said the awards were an opportunity to celebrate the people and projects that make Western Australia's building industry truly world-class.

“The projects that were before us this year showcased an extraordinary breadth of talent – from large-scale commercial developments to finely detailed residential work,” said Mr Shaw.

“They highlight the skill, resilience, and ingenuity of builders who are not only shaping our built environment but also contributing to stronger, more sustainable communities.”

“The judging process we undertook was rigorous; it was conducted with independence, integrity, and deep respect for the craft. It has been a privilege to see first-hand the craftsmanship and professionalism that drives our industry forward.”

“Every finalist and winner tonight deserves recognition for their outstanding contribution,” he concluded.
